INTERNAL

- Recruiting of new institutions: 20+ member institutions by July 2019, with 20+ additional institutions exploring
- Fundraising: Expand annual budget to \$215,000
 - Congregational dues & fundraising
 - Individual and corporate donors
 - Foundation grants
- Leadership training: 50+ new leaders through introductory training, 5+ through in-depth training
- Congregational development: Stewardship and other training for clergy and lay leaders
- Staff expansion: Recruitment and hiring of two new organizers

EXTERNAL

- Help end the opioid epidemic:
 - Remove barriers and improve access to effective treatment
 - Research and improve addiction treatment in the criminal justice system
 - Encourage proven prevention practices in schools
 - Engage 40+ congregations in reducing stigma around addiction and medication-assisted treatment
 - Make the opioid industry part of the solution
- Explore other interests and issues on Long Island, including:
 - Broader mental health concerns and challenges
 - o Work with the *Do Not Stand Idly By* gun safety campaign
 - o Stability and security in immigrant communities
 - Criminal justice reform
